Rachael Heath resigns as Weatherly superintendent; WASD/WEA contract signed

The Weatherly Area School Board at a special meeting held on Monday, June 7 unanimously, and with regret, accepted the resignation of district Superintendent Dr. Rachael Heath. Heath will be leaving the district at the end of July. High School principal Stu Tripler will serve as acting superintendent from that time until the district selects a replacement.

Most of the district's teachers greeted the 6-2 vote that approved a new contract with applause. The contract had expired prior to the start of the school year, which ends this week, and the four-year pact will carry the Weatherly Education

Association through to the conclusion of the 2006-2007 school year. After board member Gary Makuch made a motion to approve the contract and it received a second from John Ursta, Larry Palmer asked that the vote be tabled until all board members could be present. At the beginning of the meeting two of the nine members were not in attendance, Gerry Grega and Bonnie Barbush. Barbush arrived prior to the vote on the contract, but Palmer asked if the vote could be held off until later in the meeting when Grega might also be present. Frank Migneco offered
